Congressman Louis Stokes Endorses Chandra for Attorney General: "Chandra is the Best Person for the Job"

Cleveland, Ohio – Former Congressman Louis Stokes has endorsed Subodh Chandra in the Democratic Primary for Ohio Attorney General, saying that **"Subodh's proven track record as a federal prosecutor and Cleveland Law Director indicates that he is the best person for the job.
